

Australian Outback Eclipse

November 28 - December 10, 2002

Dear Eclipse Traveler,

The December 4, 2002 total eclipse of the sun in Australia is unique for a number of reasons. First, the duration of totality is short, just 26-32 seconds, depending upon where you are. Second, it occurs at sunset, meaning that in cloud-free conditions, you can see the setting crescent sun dip below a stark Outback horizon just minutes after totality. Lastly, it occurs in Australia - the land of the Great Barrier Reef, Ayers Rock, marvelous dark southern skies and the famous Outback.

With the help of meteorologist Jay Anderson and countless others, TravelQuest has brought together all the best Australia has to offer, along with the VERY BEST PROSPECTS OF SEEING THE ECLIPSED SETTING SUN. Once again, we have determined the best location to observe the eclipse, and secured the most desirable accommodations in closest proximity to our viewing site.

We think this itinerary captures the heart of the Australian experience - the Outback (where you will see the eclipse), gorgeous Sydney and cosmopolitan Melbourne, the Great Barrier Reef, pristine Kangaroo Island, and Adelaide's beautiful wine-country.

Itinerary

Day 1 Thu, November 28, 2002 Los Angeles - Sydney

Afternoon departure from Los Angeles to Sydney on *Qantas Airways*, losing one day flying over the International Dateline. Travelers are encouraged to arrive in Sydney a day or two early to recover from the long flight and enjoy Sydney's attractions. Evening arrival into Sydney. After clearing customs, you will be transferred to the Westin Hotel for a well-deserved nights sleep.

Day 3 Sat, Nov 30 Sights of Sydney

After breakfast we'll embark on a morning tour of Sydney. We'll travel through the historical "Rocks" area, cross the Harbour and the Spit Bridges, see the famous Manly Surf Beach, and enjoy spectacular views of the Harbour from special vantage points. We'll also see Sydney's renowned city sights - The Bridge, Australia's oldest house Cadman's Cottage, the Opera House, Darling Harbour, and the infamous Kings Cross. You'll also see Bondi Beach, and the exclusive suburbs of Double Bay and Vaucluse and the trendy terrace homes of Paddington. Later, we'll board our Captain Cook Cruise, to view this beautiful city from the water, while enjoying a delicious lunch. Later, we'll gather for dinner in a restaurant overlooking Sydney Harbour.

Day 4 Sun, Dec 01 Cairns Rainforest

We'll return to Cairns via the famous Skyrail, the world's only Rainforest Cableway. 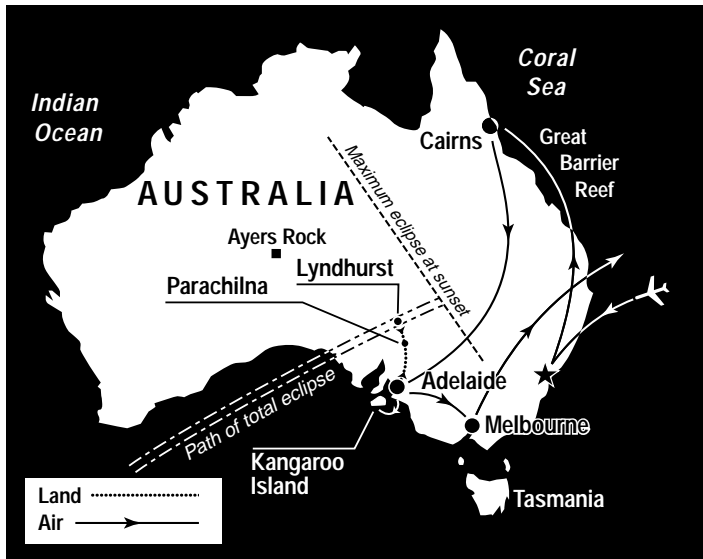

Day 5 Mon, Dec 02 Great Barrier Reef Catamaran

This morning we'll journey north along the coast to Port Douglas enjoying spectacular views of the Coral Sea and tropical beaches. Upon arrival we'll board Quicksilver, a Wavepiercing Catamaran, for a day on the outer barrier reef. On the way out to the reef, a presentation will be made by the staff marine biologist. Morning and afternoon tea, as well as a tropical smorgasbord lunch will be served on board. There will be time to snorkel (equipment included), and view fish and coral from an underwater observatory as well as via a semi-submersible vessel. You may choose to do optional scuba diving or see the Reef by helicopter.

Day 6 Tue, Dec 03 Adelaide

Early morning transfer to the Cairns Airport for our flight to Adelaide. Upon arrival in Adelaide, we will travel by motorcoach to the Barossa Valley, famous for its vineyards and winemaking. After a delicious lunch and wine tasting at a local winery, we will continue on to the famed Australian Outback and the beautiful Prairie Hotel in Parachilna. The Prairie Hotel perfectly blends Outback adventure with a slice of air-conditioned luxury. Enjoy dinner prepared by the hotel's award winning chef. Day 7 Wed, Dec 04 Eclipse Day in the Outback!

After breakfast we will tour through the Flinders Mountain Ranges, watching wildlife come in to water at the meandering Nilpena Springs, and view relics of the area's aboriginal and pastoral heritage. After lunch, we will proceed to our eclipse viewing area in Lyndhurst with plenty of time to prepare for the eclipse. Our motorcoach will be on standby in the unlikely event of cloudy weather. Latitude and longitude for Lyndhurst: 30'28" S and 138'35" E.

Day 8 Thu, Dec 05 Adelaide

After breakfast, our coach will take us to Adelaide for a brief city sightseeing tour, traveling along North Terrace, which is the cultural boulevard of the city, and on to Montefiore Hill for great views of the city. We'll have a private lunch at the South Australian Museum and then enjoy a short tour of the Aboriginal section of the museum. This evening, enjoy Adelaide as you wish. **Overnight: Holiday Inn Adelaide (two nights) (BL)**

Day 9 Fri, Dec 06 Kangaroo Island

This morning we'll transfer to Adelaide Airport for our short flight to Kangaroo Island, to enjoy a full day tour of this magical island preserve. You'll have an opportunity to walk in the wild with seals on the beach, view koalas in their natural habitat and see unusual rock formations and other wildlife. A memorable barbecue lunch will be served. After your all day tour we will fly back to Adelaide for an evening of exploring on our own. **(BL)**

Day 10 Sat, Dec 07 Melbourne

After breakfast we'll transfer to Adelaide Airport for our flight to Melbourne. Upon arrival, we'll take a city tour including spectacular views of the city from the newly completed Bolte Bridge, Colonial Stadium, The Shrine of Remembrance, the Cathedrals, Collins Street, State Parliament House - a magnificent example of Victorian architecture -and the city's famous parks and gardens.

Day 11 Sun, Dec 08 Great Ocean Road

Today, we'll depart Melbourne for a full day tour down the Great Ocean Road, a portion of which was built as a memorial to those who died during the First World War. Along the way you'll marvel at the huge cliffs, roaring seas, tranquil coves and swimming beaches. The highlight of today's journey is the sight of the "twelve apostles" grand sandstone cones emerging from the sea. **(BL)**

What to Expect

Australia is large enough to have significant variations in weather. We will travel from the tropical Barrier Reef to the hot, dry Outback. December is early-summer in Australia. The dry southern coastal region experiences daytime highs in the 80s, with lows in the 50s. Our Outback eclipse viewing site will have daytime highs in the 100's - similar to those encountered in southern Turkey during the 1999 eclipse. The tropical northeastern region experiences daytime highs in the 80-90s, with lows in the 70s, and a likelihood of rain. There are no current health alerts for travel to Australia. For up to date health information visit the Centers for Disease Control <www.cdc.gov/travel/#Geographic>.

Aside from extreme heat in the Outback, this is not a strenuous trip. There will be optional opportunities for hikes and walks throughout the tour.
